Financial Report

Arnie reported that the organization has over \$12,000 in the bank, and said that we are in the best shape we've ever been. This reflects the money given us by the Soboba Foundation (\$10,000). Also, because of the coronavirus, we aren't holding classes and expenditures are at a minimum.

Reopening, when, how
